## Husbands

1. Are you choosing your wife over the Lord in any area of your life?
2. Do you accept responsibility for all failures in your marriage or do you blame your wife (or even God)?
3. Why did the Lord make you ruler over your wife?
4. If your wife works outside the home, why are you allowing/forcing her to endure the curse that is rightfully yours?

## Wives

1. How are you protecting yourself from being deceived by Satan/others?
2. If there is something your husband needs to do to lead your marriage and doesn't do it, do you just go ahead and do it? Are you willing to leave it undone even if it results in adversity in your life and marriage?
3. Do you accept blame for your failures in your marriage or do you blame others?
4. Wives may be tempted to use emotions, sex, anger, silence, rebellion, and other things to try to exert control over their husbands. Are you employing any devices to try to exercise sway over your husband?

## Couples

1. Do you study and discuss the word of God together? Do you work through any disagreements concerning what God says?
2. Discuss whether Scripture allows the roles of husbands and wives to change as culture and society change.
3. It is often frustrating to try to follow a ruler when the "rules" of the game are unknown. Discuss where you are going as a couple and how you plan to get there. Also, discuss each other's roles and responsibilities in this plan.
