## Husbands

1. Are you intimate with your wife? How can you become more intimate with her?
2. Do you accept counsel from your wife? Do you really want her to tell you what you need to hear?
3. Have you laid out the household responsibilities for your wife, both from God's standpoint and yours?

## Wives

1. Are you an older woman? If so, who are you discipling to be a good wife?
2. Are you a younger woman? If so, who are you seeking for godly counsel and example on how to be a good wife?
3. Do you believe the responsibilities of a wife are sacred duties (cf. *be reverent* in Titus 2:3)? Does your behavior reflect this belief?
4. Is your husband your friend (cf. Luke 10:29, 36)?
5. Do you tell others intimate details about your husband and marriage? If so, ponder why you aren't satisfied with pouring out your soul to only the Lord.
6. Where is the majority of your energy spent – inside or outside the home? Does something need to change?

## Couples

1. Are you friends?
2. Do you still have fun together? What fun thing do you have planned for this week?
3. How can a mother be a friend to her children without compromising her role as a parent?
